Monthly Recipe



A simple marinade makes these grilled pork chops wonderfully tender and tasty!

Grilled Pork Chops

PREP TIME 5 minutes

COOK TIME 20 minutes

MARINATING TIME 2 hours

TOTAL TIME 2 hours 25 minutes

SERVINGS 6 servings



Ingredients

- 1/2 lemon juiced
- 1/4 cup olive oil
- 1 tablespoon soy sauce
- 1/2 teaspoon garlic powder
- 1/4 teaspoon basil
- 1/4 teaspoon oregano
- salt and pepper to taste
- 4-6 boneless loin chops 3/4" thick

Instructions

- Combine all marinade ingredients in a large freezer bag. Add pork chops and marinate at least 2 hours.
- 2. Preheat grill to medium high.
- 3. Grill pork 5-7 minutes per side or until temperature reaches 145°F. Do not overcook.
- 4. Let pork rest on a plate 5 minutes before serving.






Each year Packards of Chicagoland hosts an evening out at a popular restaurant in the northern suburbs of Chicago.
