REMINDERS NO LONGER BEING MAILED

At the Board meeting on November 12, Lee Nelson reported that because of the budget crisis in Illinois, the Secretary of State's office will no longer send out a reminder that your license plates are expiring. This will save the state \$450,000 a month in postage.

The upshot of this is that YOU NEED TO

REMEMBER when your license plates expire. Doug Finke, writing for the State Journal Register, said the suspension of renewal notices is immediate. "A lot of people have grown to rely on these notices so then they know when to come into a facility or reg-



ister online," Henry Haupt, Jesse White spokesman, said.

People can still get notices by email if they register online. You may do that through the Secretary of State's site, cyberdriveillinois.com. There is a link there for you to do that. It does ask for your registration number and PIN. If you don't have a renewal notice or a current registration card, please call the Public Inquiry Division at 800-252-8980 to obtain your Registration ID and PIN number.

So, go outside and check when your license plates expire, come in and mark it on your calendar. Start 2016 with a reminder because the state of Illinois will no longer help with this task.

From the kitchen of:

BONNIE STARCZYK

Bonnie says this dish is versatile and can be used as a side dish or a main course if you add a salad.

FARFALLE WITH MUSHROOMS & PEAS

5 slices of bacon cut in small pieces,

- 1 large onion chopped,
- 8 oz of white button mushroom or baby portabella, chopped,
- 1 large bay leaf,
- 1 large can of whole tomatoes (28 oz),



- $\frac{1}{4}$ cup of mascarpone cheese (or cream cheese),
- 1 box of frozen sweet peas.
- 1 lb of farfalle pasta
- 1. Cook pasta according to directions.
- 2. In large sauté pan (or Dutch oven) fry bacon until crisp and fat is rendered, add chopped onion and fry until softened and is translucent.
- 3. Add chopped mushroom and bay leaf and cook for 5-7 minutes until all ingredients are soft.
- 4. Add tomatoes with juice and crush tomatoes with wooden spoon and simmer additional 10 minutes.
- 5. Turn off heat under sauce then add frozen peas and mascarpone cheese mixing gently till cheese is blended.
- 6. Add drained hot pasta to sauce, mix, and let it stand for few minutes before serving.

Welcome: President Juday called the meeting to order at 11:09 a.m. He thanked the Momence Chapter for hosting the meeting and Pat Hart, Jeanne Marcotte and Shirley Salm for serving breakfast before the meeting started.

Roll Call: Conducted by the Secretary. Board members present were Don Juday, Shirley Salm, Nancy Juday, Lee Nelson, Dan Sobczyk, Al Matison, Linda Dolezal, Pat Markert, Joe Dolezal, Bob Markert, Nancy Nelson, Jeanne Marcotte, Darlene Sobczyk, Rick Shaw and Chris Schurrer. Linda Dolezal was proxy for Bob Grutza and Sam Houston for Ernie Hart. John Otto was excused.

Secretary's Report: There were three corrections to the report. In the Fox Valley report, the Chicago Map Society tour should have read to Lake Geneva. In the New Business section, it should have read, Chris Schurrer is willing to set up a Region Facebook Page, but someone to maintain it is needed. The adjournment time should have been 12:12, not 2:12. Bob Markert moved to accept the report as corrected. Al Matison seconded, motion passed.

Treasurer's Report: Nancy Juday reported that the beginning balance was \$10,311.25. Income was \$2595.00 which consisted of renewals coming in. Expenses were \$1,141.99 leaving a balance of \$11,764.26 as of November 14, 2015. There were no expenses for the Fall Tour from the Des Plaines Valley Chapter. She thanked the members for keeping the expenses down. Chris Schurrer moved to accept the Treasurer's report. Bob Markert seconded, motion passed.

Vice President's Report: There was no report due to Ernie Hart's absence.

President's Report: President Juday reported that the Fall Tour was very enjoyable and it was a beautiful day for the Brighton Run this year. Dues Renewal notices have been mailed out and encouraged all members to send them in soon. The ballot for the election of Board members has been sent out and he encouraged all members to be sure to vote. The National AACA is having a

contest for the Chapters and Regions to get more members. He feels our Region needs to pass on that contest. Please let him know when members are ill so that cards can be sent to them.

Committee Reports:

Membership - Linda & Joe Dolezal reported that the renewals were sent out on October 16, and 99 have been received back. They are encouraged that half of the members have renewed and hopes that the remainder will return theirs soon.

Publications - Pat Markert reported that she will publish illnesses in *Sidelights* and encourage members to send cards to these members.

Website - Dan Sobczyk reported that he posts *Sidelights* on the website and he only lists the events for the Region, not the individual Chapters. Chapter Presidents should contact him if they want their events listed on the website.

Legislation: Lee Nelson reported that the State of Illinois will not send out notices for renewal of license plates. Darlene Sobczyk mentioned that the website has a number to call to get the pin number to renew your license through the internet.

Archivist: Chris Schurrer reported that he has 12 boxes of the Lenard Pal collection ready to go to Auburn. It was decided to try to sell this collection at the Swap Meet. We will need a person to be in charge of this at the Meet. Chris has several flyers of car shows and meets that are sponsored by organizations other than our Chapters and Region. He wants to know what he should do with them. A motion was made by Pat Markert for him to throw them away and seconded by Bob Markert. After a discussion, Pat Markert made a motion to rescind the first motion and let Chris use his discretion on what to do with them. Al Matison seconded, motion passed.

Region Activities

Fall Tour 2015 - Des Plaines Valley - Lee Nelson reported that the weather was a bit nippy for the tour that included 18 cars and 30 members. The hard luck award went to Dennis and Eileen Zecher whose car had to be flat bedded home. John and Audrey Rosentreter received the farthest traveled award. Laura McDonald won the Cocoa Cola trivia contest and the Road Rally game. He thanked Chris Schurrer for doing the tour sheets and the Road Rally game.

Swap Meet 2016 - Fox Valley - Dan Sobczyk reported the meet will be April 3, and they want to feature Studebaker, Packard, Nash, Hudson and other orphan car parts. Appropriate car clubs have been contacted. The Chevy Club is not having a swap meet this year, so they hope to have a bigger crowd and more vendors. He will see if the dealership will allow them to have outside vendors this year.

Spring Tour 2016 - Momence - Jeanne Marcotte reported that they will probably have their head-quarters in the Bourbonnais area. There are several interesting collections to visit locally.

Region Car Show 2016 - Bob Markert reported it will be the same as last year. He can't make any final plans with Cantigny until after the first of the year.
