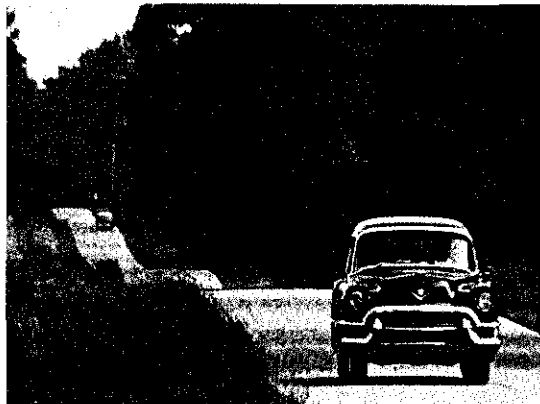

From our starting point, we will be traveling the back roads of DuPage County past forest preserves, golf courses, historic sites and various points of interest. One interesting point is the old Ovaltine Plant which has been turned into condos.

Our tour stop will be at the Lizzadro Museum of Lapidary Art is located in beautiful Wilder Park in Elmhurst, Illinois. The museum opens at 1 PM but we can explore Wilder Park, which was originally the Wilder Estate and occupies one city block near downtown Elmhurst. On the grounds are a conservatory and the restored Wilder mansion. The museum contains a history of Lapidary Art. The museum is a Blue Star Facility and veterans are admitted free with credentials.

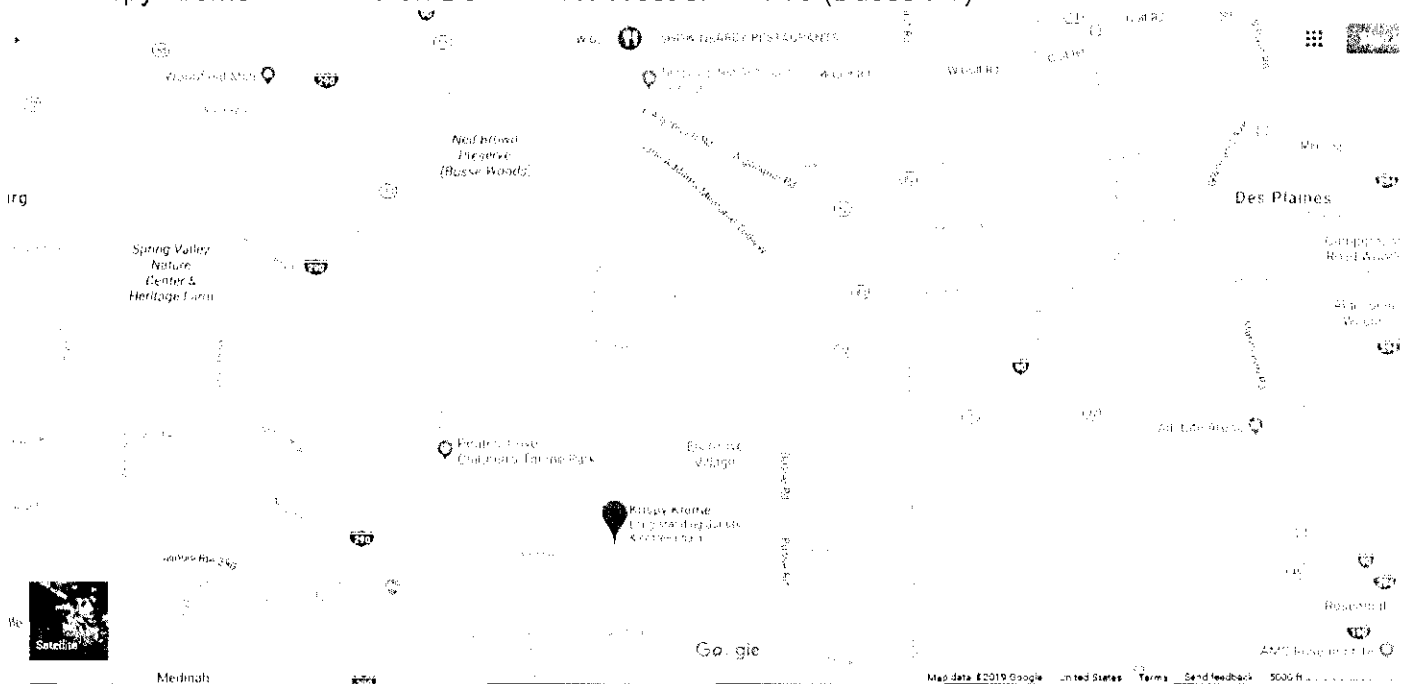

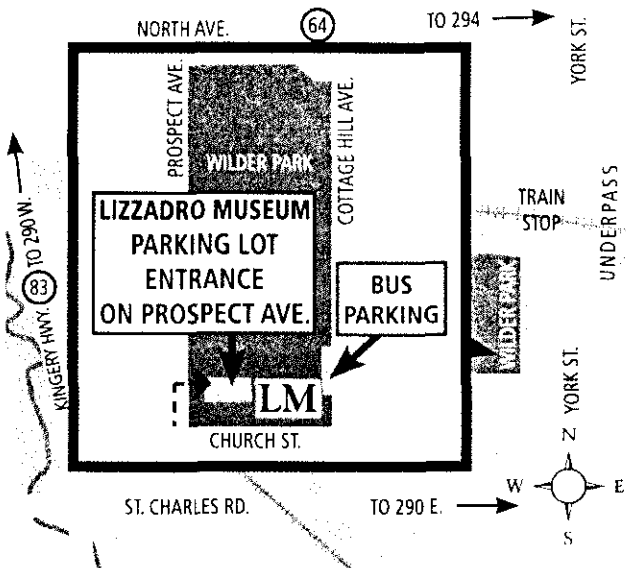

Location of our starting point: Krispy Kreme Donuts, 412 Devon Avenue, Elk Grove, IL.  
 Krispy Kreme is located on Devon Ave. West of Rte. 83 (Busse Rd)



Directions to our starting point from the North:

- 1) Using toll road. Go south on I-94, keep right onto I-294 (south). Use the right two lanes and take exit 40B, for Interstate 90W to Rockford. Use the left two lanes to merge onto I-90 W. Use the right two lanes to take the Elmhurst Road N exit. Keep left at the fork and follow signs for Elmhurst Rd. S and continue south on Elmhurst Road to Devon. Turn Right on Devon to Krispy Kreme.
- 2) Local Roads Head south on IL-Rte. 83 to Arlington Heights Road and continue south on Arlington Heights Road for 11 miles to Landmeier Road. Turn left on Landmeier and go 0.6 miles to Tonne Rd. Turn Right on Tonne and go 1.6 miles to Devon Ave. Turn right onto Devon and proceed to Krispy Kreme.

The Lizzadro Museum Of Lapidary Art ,

Lapidary is the art of cutting and polishing stone. Lapidary has its roots in prehistory, as early humans began fashioning tools and weapons from stone. In time, these techniques were also used for items of personal adornment. Stone carving evolved as an art in many cultures throughout the world. During the 1950s, lapidary became a popular hobby in the United States. Hobbyists enjoyed cutting and polishing gemstones and mounting them in prefabricated jewelry settings or in metalwork of their own creation.
