Monthly Recipe



Apple Cinnamon Cake

Delicious cake to make during apple picking season.

<u>Ingredients:</u>

- 2 cups all-purpose flour
- 1 large apple, peeled and chopped
- 1 cup vegetable oil
- 1 cup dark brown sugar
- 1/2 cup granulated white sugar
- 1/2 cup walnuts, chopped
- 2 large eggs
- 1 tablespoon ground cinnamon
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1/2 teaspoon baking powder
- 1/2 teaspoon baking soda
- 1/2 teaspoon salt

Directions:

Preheat oven to 350°F and lightly grease a 9-inch round cake pan.

In a medium bowl, mix together the eggs and oil. Add the cinnamon, white and brown sugars, and vanilla extract and mix until combined.

Add the flour, salt, baking soda, and baking powder, and mix until thoroughly incorporated. Fold in the apples and the nuts and pour batter into prepared pan. Bake until a toothpick inserted into the center comes out clean, about 45 minutes. Let cool for 15 minutes before slicing and serving.

Welcome: President Dan Sobczyk called the meeting to order at 10:52 am.

Dan welcomed the members of the board and thanked Umberto Garcia for providing the building and the refreshments for the meeting.

Roll Call: Secretary took the roll call. Attending Board Members: Dan Sobczyk, Pat Markert, Bob Wenderski, Dale Woolsley, Bill Vroman, John O'Halloran, Lee Nelson, Nancy Nelson. Treasurer Report: Bob Wenderski reported that overall the balance in the treasury has gone down because of no Swap Meet and no Car Show for several years. The number of members though has shown little fluctuation. A motion was made by Bill Vroman and seconded by John O'Halloran to accept the treasurer's report. The motion carried.

STANDING COMMITTEES:

Membership: Bob Markert reported that Andy Voss is planning on initiating the 2023 membership drive in October. To that end, he is asking Chapter Presidents if there are any changes to the fee structure for their chapters.

Andy also asked about name tags for new members. Discussion ensued. It was decided that when an individual joins, the membership chair will continue to give them a temporary name tag. If they renew their membership for a second year, they will then be given a permanent name tag. Members who have lost their original name tag, may purchase another for \$12. Andy Voss will serve another year as Membership Chair.

Publication: no report

Legislative: Lee Nelson reported that the deadline for road tests has been moved again, this time to December 1. Lee will serve another year.

Website: Bill Vroman, new web master, reported that he had already made several changes to the website including a new look, larger print and revised links to specific pages. He is asking members to send stories and pictures directly to him for inclusion on the site. Bill is currently researching various ways to enable members and visitors to pay on line for show registrations, chapter dues and tour fees. Bill has accepted the challenges associated with the website and will serve another year.

Archives: Bob Markert reported for Chris Schurrer that the archives have been buy. We have received several donations of sets of magazines which are currently being inventoried. Several dozen signs from the Region trailer were donated. Most have been turned over to the Region Car Show and the Silver Springs Car Show. Lastly, we have received boxes of trophies which will be inventoried. Chris had requests for the 1989, 2019 and 2022 Spring Tour sheets from a member of the Fox Valley chapter. These have been sent. Chris will serve another year as archivist.

ACTIVITIES:

Swap Meet—Bob Markert reported that Don McCue Chevrolet has been sold. We don't yet know if they will still accommodate our swap meet. We hope to know more soon. If not, other venues will have to be found and explored.

Region Car Show 2022: Bob Markert reported that pre-registrations were: 13 members/15 nonmembers. Day of registrations: 7 members and 25 non-members. He felt that the numbers were lower for at least two reasons: we were late deciding to go ahead with show, so notices went out late; fewer flyers were distributed because there were fewer at which to give them out; the rain. Both last year and this, the weather was not smiling on us.

Fall Tour:

Bob Markert reported for John Medgyesi that they are working on the fall tour. They have gotten the hotel (Quality Inn/ 200 Gore Rd., Morris, IL/ 815-942-6600/ Oct. 20-23. They also have scheduled 2 car collections, a tour to an apple orchard and other good things. They are also working on a couple of other stops.

CHAPTER REPORTS:

Des Plaines Valley: Lee Nelson that members attended the memorial for Paul Terhorst; worked at the Cantigny Show; have contributed to Sidelights and are planning to travel to Sublette for the show there.

Silver Springs: Bob Markert reported for John Medgyesi that the chapter has already started planning for next year's car show. They are currently negotiating with the fair grounds, have set contacts with vendors, have arranged for someone to make the plates.

Waukegan-North Shore: no report

OLD BUSINESS:

Business Cards: Everyone seemed to think this is a good idea. Discussed were size of card, wording and members receiving them. Bill Vroman is looking into more details.

CCCA Tour Participation: This group was invited to the spring tour. No one signed up. Dan, who had talked to Russ Rodriguez, President, felt the next move is up to them.

NEW BUSINESS:

Region Car Show 2023:

The biggest discussion here was that many people who contacted Bob Markert asked to pay on-line. Bill Vroman is looking into getting help from National AACA and into finding a more economical way to do this. What he had found out so far is that it is too expensive. Dan suggested being able to do on-line pay for dues as well as registration for both the Region and Silver Springs car show. Bob and Jim Sikora are modifying some of the car show procedures. John O' Halloran suggested that the feature cars be parked adjacent to each other. Everyone seemed amiable to that.

Ballot Committee:

Pat Markert reported that since we have not had an election during Covid that they had to go back several years for a member of the last ballot committee to chair this year's group. The whole ballot committee will consist of Jim & Marcia Sikora, Pat and Bob Markert and 2 others to be determined. She reminded chapter Presidents that they need to submit a nominee to run for the board by October 1. She told the board that if they know someone who they think would be a good addition to the board, they should contact her and she would have Bob call and talk to them. Dale Woolsley and Dan Sobczyk, whose terms are ending, said they would run again. Bibiana Garca said she would run and Lee Nelson submitted John Otto's name from Des Plaines chapter.

By-Law Discussion: Pat Markert suggested that there need to be some changes to the by-laws as we have changed the way we do things and we need to bring the by-laws into compliance. She offered copies of the by-laws to those who don't have them and suggested they be studied to see if there are other areas to be changed. This will be addressed at next board meeting.

She reminded board members that nominees for the Lichtfeld Award will be made at the next meeting.

NEXT BOARD MEETING: Will be hosted by Des Plaines Valley Chapter on November 12, 2022. More information to follow.

ADJOURN: Dan asked for a motion to adjourn before Bob Markert lost his voice. The motion was made by John O'Halloran and seconded by Umberto Garcia. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 12:32 pm.
