Monthly Recipe



Scones Submitted by Chris Schurrer

Ingredients

1-3/4 cups flour
1/4 cup sugar
1 tablespoon plus 1 teaspoon baking powder
1/2 teaspoon cinnamon
1/8 teaspoon salt
5 tablespoons unsalted butter, softened
1/2 cup dried currants
1/2 cup chocolate chips
1/2 cup plus 1 tablespoon milk
1/4 cup sour cream
1 egg

Instructions

1. Heat the oven to 400 degrees. Sift the flour, sugar, baking powder, cinnamon, and salt into a large bowl. Cut in the butter using a pastry blender until it is in sizes similar to a pea. Stir in currants and chocolate chips.

2. Mix together 1/2 cup of the milk and the sour cream; pour into the dry ingredients. Stir mixture gently until ingredients are thoroughly combined.

3. Pat dough into an 8-inch circle on a floured board; cut with a pizza cutter into eight or more wedges (if you want, you could flatten the dough and cut out circles with a biscuit or cookie cutter). Place scones on a greased baking sheet at least 1 inch apart; set aside. Whisk together the egg and remaining 1 tablespoon of milk. Brush the tops of the scones with the egg wash; let rest 10 minutes. Bake until golden brown, about 15 minutes. Serve warm with butter or clotted cream and a selection of jams.



It was really lovely to get together again. Lousy weather, but good food and good friends make it a winner of an evening.






