- 1. Place pretzels in a large bowl that has a sealed cover.
- 2. Sprinkle dry ingredients over pretzels.
- 3. Cover the bowl and shake well until pretzels are coated.
- 4. Pour oil over pretzels cover and shake well again.
- 5. Be sure to gently stir, scraping the seasonings from the bottom of the bowl.
- 6. Serve and enjoy.
