She and Warren have been members of the Illinois Region since 1979. They both were very active and enjoyed tours, car shows and parties.


Sylvia also served the Region by editing <u>Sidelights</u> for more than 12 years, winning many certificates of excellence from the National for the work she did.

On February 25th the Silver Springs Chapter gathered together at the Yorkville Bowl, just south of Rte. 34 in Yorkville.


The group enjoyed some fun and exercise on the bowling alleys along with conversation and snacks. It was a good time.

What a wonderful time we had getting together again.








