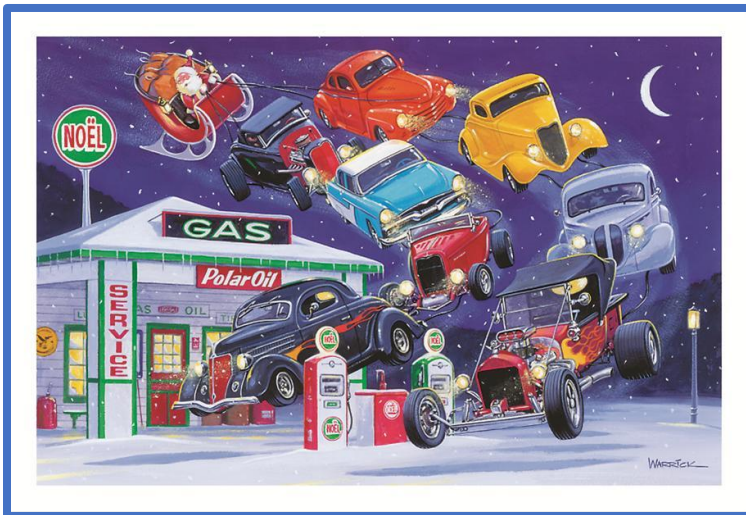

# Monthly Recipe



The winter season was made for fresh warm bread.



## Rye Bread

(Recipe provided by Chris Schurrer)

2 pkg. yeast  
 $\frac{1}{4}$  cup lukewarm water  
2 cups milk (scalded)  
2 tsp. salt  
3 tbsp. dark molasses  
1 tbsp. shortening  
2 cups Rye Flour  
About 4  $\frac{1}{4}$  cups White Flour

Dissolve yeast in 1/4 cup lukewarm water.

Combine hot milk, sugar, salt, and shortening, cool to lukewarm, add 2 cups rye flour, beat well, then add yeast and enough white flour to make moderate stiff dough. Knead until smooth and satiny, place in a greased bowl, let rise until double in bulk, punch down, rise again, then make into two (2) loaves, rise until double in bulk.

Bake at 400 degrees for 35 minute or until done.

Note: You may use Caraway Seeds if you so desire, about 2 teaspoons.

## Illinois Region Board Meeting Minutes

November 13, 2021

Host: Des Plaines Valley Chapter

White Oak Library District, Crest Hill, IL

Vice President Chris Schurrer called the meeting to order at 11:06 a.m.

**Roll Call:** Present: Chris Schurrer, Bob Wenderski, Lee Nelson, John Medgyesi, Ed Flynn proxy for Harold Flood, Jerry Bodden, Bill Vroman proxy for Joanna Vroman, Dale Woosley, Jo Ann Flynn, Bill Vroman, Andy Voss. Guests: Bob Markert, Pat Markert, Nancy Nelson.

**Secretary's Report:** Jo Ann Flynn, acting secretary for this meeting, asked if there were any corrections to the minutes from the last meeting. There were none. Bob Markert motioned to accept the minutes as written. Ed Flynn seconded. Motion passed.

**Treasurer's Report:** Bob Wenderski reported a current balance of \$22,444.47. We have been receiving payments for memberships for 2022. YTD Income less Expenses is -\$9.05. A motion was made by Andy Voss to accept the Treasurer's Report as presented. Bill Vroman seconded. Motion passed.

### Standing Committee Reports:

**Membership** - Andy Voss reported that the Membership Renewal Drive is underway and he has received about a third of the renewals back to date. Bob Markert asked about adding the date when members joined. Discussion followed about contacting National for info and also asking members for their join date.

**Publication** - Chris Schurrer reported that Laura Cielinski, Sidelights Editor, requested that you send articles to her as early as possible for admission in Sidelights.

**Legislation** - Lee Nelson stated there was no significant legislation pertaining to classic vehicles at this time. He reminded members that Drivers License renewals that were extended due to Covid are expiring Dec. 31st. Jerry Bodden asked about possible legislation that would eliminate a front license plate. Discussion followed. No real answers from government but doesn't appear to be moving forward.

**Website** - Chris Schurrer reported no changes to the website, but requested that flyers for events or any other items be sent to Dan Sobczyk as early as possible for posting on the website.

**Archivist** - Chris Schurrer reported that he has received donations of items from several people, including various car magazines. These items will be reviewed for items of interest to our club and the remaining passed on to other appropriate groups. He has received 3 requests from members for previous Brighton Run Dash Plaques. We are using some of the tours previously written and held in the archives for tours. He reminded the group that the Archives are available to any member for research.

### **Region Activities:**

**Swap Meet 2022** - Bob Markert reported that it is planned for the first Sunday in April (4/3/22). The flyer must be ready by the end of December so we must decide at this meeting if we are doing the event. A discussion followed. Concern was that we would need about 30 people for the event. John Medgyesi stated that the Silver Springs chapter would help with setup as usual. The consensus of the group was that we would have enough people to staff the event and we will move forward with it.

**Spring Tour 2022** - Chris Schurrer reported that the tour is still in a holding pattern due to Covid impact. The goal is to know by the January Board Meeting if we can move forward with the tour. The places on the tours are not being committal about availability next year at this time. A long discussion ensued about pricing of hotels. Many factors determine acceptable rates, such as other costs for the tours, hospitality room as part of package and locations. Tour leaders must negotiate reasonable packages for members. A question was raised as to possibly doing the tours during the week to obtain lower hotel costs, but since not all members are retired and we want to encourage younger members joining the club, that idea was not pursued.

**Region Car Show 2022** - Bob Markert reported that he is still waiting on confirmation from Cantigny about the dates, but it appears like the show will proceed. Expected dates are the 3rd or 4th week in July. We will need volunteers but also members to bring their cars.

**Fall Tour 2022** - John Medgyesi reported that the tour is on hold at this time but it is planned for the Yorkville area. Chris commented that once things are back to normal, we will resume our usual rotation schedule for the chapters hosting tours.

## **Chapter Reports:**

**Des Plaines Valley** - Lee Nelson reported that the chapter assisted with the Fall Tour and they hosted this board meeting. They have a new member, Kevin Perkins. The Air Shows are not happening at this time and he suspects will not happen in the near future due to changes within the organization that hosts the Air Show.

**Fox Valley** - Chris Schurrer reported that they hosted a tour to Oregon Illinois in October and it was very nice, with beautiful weather and a good boat tour. It was well attended. January 29th is the date for the FV Holiday party.

**Silver Springs** - John Medgyesi reported that they recently lost a member, Jack Weymouth. They are working on the Car Show for next year and are increasing the food trucks compared to last year's show. It will be the 50th show for them. They have been doing their regular monthly meetings and have a tentative date for their Holiday party of Jan. 9th.

**Waukegan/North Shore** - Chris Schurrer reported on the Brighton Run. They had 85 cars registered, great weather and a stop at Richardson Farm. The event was hosted by Harold and Carroll Flood and Bob and Sue Wenderski, who also planned the route. They had found numerous new roads to travel. The chapter Holiday Party is planned for Dec. 5th at Jerry's Parkway by the Lake. They will hold their election of officers at the party.

## **Old Business:**

**Region brochures** - Jo Ann Flynn reported that the brochures have been update, printed and distributed to Chapter Presidents and Andy Voss. Additional copies can be made from the pdf file sent out.

**Business Cards** - Chris Schurrer asked again about printing business size cards that can be handed out to encourage new members, as suggested previously by Jim Sikora. A discussion ensued about the usage and many felt it would be useful to have the cards. Jo Ann Flynn made a motion to move forward with the idea. Dale Woosley seconded and the motion passed. Chris will work with Jim Sikora to draft the card for the next meeting.

**Tent/Canopy for Illinois Region Shows** - Chris Schurrer reported that he has not found good pricing or availability for a tent but is still looking.



## **New Business:**

**Calendar of Events for 2022** - Chris Schurrer requested that chapters provide information to Dan Sobczyk and himself as soon as possible for any definite events. There are no summer events definitely planned as of now. Bill Vroman mentioned that the Great Race will be having an overnight stop in Plainfield next June, but he is still waiting on info to see if it could be incorporated in to a region event.

**Election of Officers** - Chris Schurrer reported that the election will take place at the board meeting in January and the board should think about board positions and what to do moving forward. Reach out to Chris or Dan Sobczyk with any questions. Chris also asked the Committee Heads if they would stay on in their roles. Andy Voss agreed to stay on as Membership Chair, Lee Nelson will remain as Legislative Chair and Chris agreed to remain as Archivist. Chris will check with Dan Sobczyk about his role as Website Chair.

**Litchfield Award** - Chris Schurrer asked the board if they felt we should present the award this year and a discussion ensued. It was decided that we will present the award this year. One member was nominated by Bob Markert, seconded by Ed Flynn. No other nominations were made. Ed Flynn moved to close nominations, Lee Nelson seconded and the motion passed. The award will be presented at the January Board Meeting.

**Name Tags for New Members** - Jo Ann Flynn asked if we could create temporary name badges for new members. After discussion about how to create them, Dale Woosley made a motion to put temporary name badges in each new member packet. Ed Flynn seconded and the motion passed. Bill Vroman offered to create the template for the badge and send to Andy Voss to be printed and distributed. The board also discussed options for printing new permanent name badges for members who joined since the last issuance of these badges and new members going forward. Chris and Dale will obtain information on costs and minimum orders.

**Visitor's Input:** None

There being no further business to discuss, Dale Woosley motioned to adjourn the meeting. Seconded by Ed Flynn and motion passed. Meeting was adjourned at 12:54 pm.

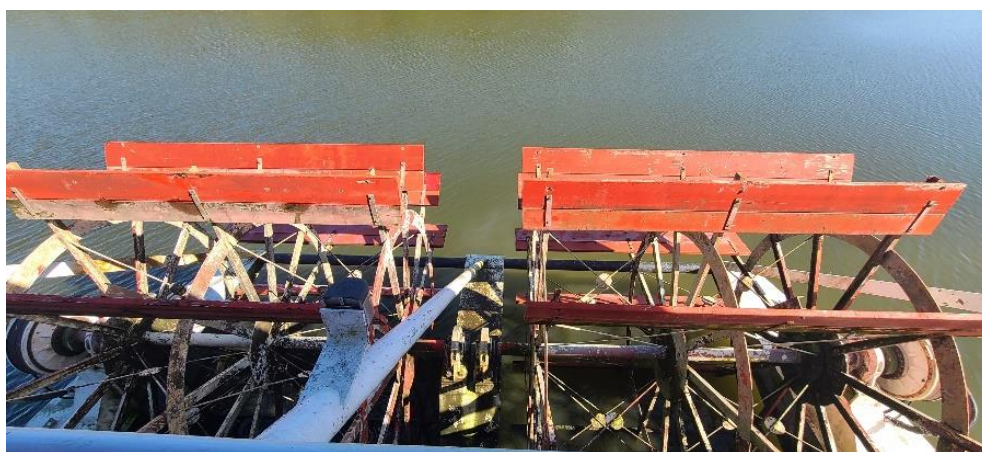

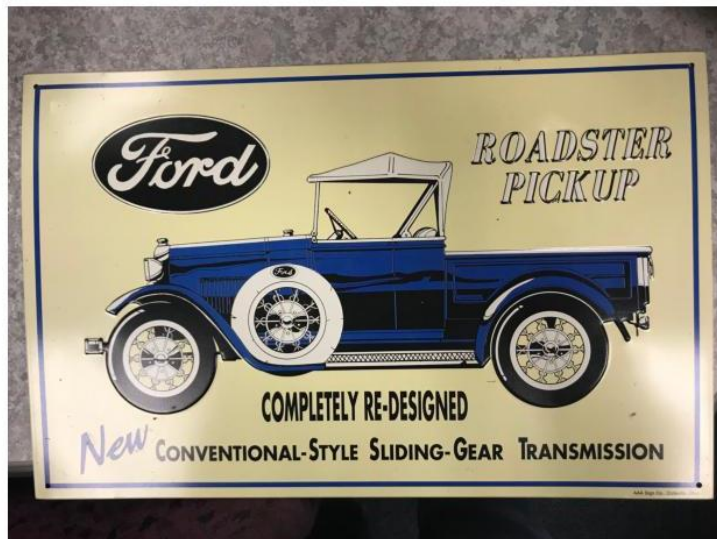
