







THE PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE



Dear Members,

As the poet Geoffrey Chaucer said" all good things must come to an end" so be it with the wonderful antique car season of 2024. Thus far it has been a great year with the cruise nights and wonderful tours that we experienced throughout the spring, summer and fall.

One of the all-time favorite annual events is happening this coming weekend, the Brighton Run presented by the Waukegan/ North Shore Chapter.

A little history about this run. On November 14, 1896, the "Light Locomotives Act" as it was known completely removed the need for a person with a lantern to walk ahead of a vehicle to warn citizens and horses of an approaching vehicle. It also raised the speed limit for "light locomotives" not exceeding 2 tons from 4 mph to 14 mph. It is the world's oldest motoring event and takes place on the first Sunday in November and is run from London to Brighton, a total of 60 miles. This year's run will be the 128th.

Also happening this month will be the AACA Board Meeting on Saturday, November 9th at 10am at the White Oak Library - Crest Hill Branch.

Monthly Recipes



Stuffing Balls

submitted by Laura Cielenski

Ingredients:

4 cups dry stuffing mix
1 cup chicken broth
1/2 cup unsalted butter, melted
2 eggs, beaten
1 small onion, finely chopped
1/2 cup celery, finely chopped
1 tsp poultry seasoning
Salt and pepper to taste
Fresh parsley, chopped for garnish

Instructions:

Preheat your oven to 350°F (175°C) and line a baking sheet with parchment paper. In a large bowl, combine the dry stuffing mix with chicken broth and melted butter. Mix until the stuffing is moistened. Stir in the beaten eggs, onion, celery, poultry seasoning, salt, and pepper. Mix until well combined.

Form the mixture into small balls, about the size of a golf ball.

Place the stuffing balls on the prepared baking sheet.

Bake for 20-25 minutes, or until they are golden brown and firm to the touch.
Remove from the oven and let them cool

slightly.

Garnish with chopped fresh parsley before serving.
