Monthly Recipe



## Ingredients

- 1 (15 ounce) can garbanzo beans, drained
- $\frac{1}{2}$  cup chopped celery
- 1 tablespoon diced onion
- 1 apple, cored and chopped
- 1 cup seedless grapes (red & or green)
- $\frac{1}{4}$  cup chopped walnuts
- $\frac{1}{2}$  head iceberg lettuce rinsed, dried, and shredded

### For the dressing:

- $\frac{1}{4}$  cup mayonnaise
- 1 tablespoon honey
- $\frac{1}{2}$  teaspoon prepared mustard
- $\frac{1}{4}$  teaspoon lemon juice

## Directions

- 1. In a large salad bowl, combine the chickpeas, celery, onion, apple and/or grapes\*, and chopped nuts.
- 2. Prepare the dressing by whisking together the mayonnaise, honey, mustard, and lemon juice in a small bowl.
- 3. Combine the salad mixture and dressing, tossing gently to coat the ingredients evenly.
- 4. Sprinkle the shredded lettuce over the salad or serve the salad mix on top of the bed of shredded lettuce and serve immediately.

\*I used both green & red grapes and apples. You can use just apples or just grapes.
