We have been blessed with great late-summer weather throughout September. The *Explore the Near North Suburbs* tour on September 6 was no exception. We began the tour in Des Plaines at the Sugar Bowl restaurant and meandered through neighborhoods on the way to our first stop at the Morton Grove Historical Society Museum. There we had an excellent guided tour of a historic home on the museum grounds. From there we continued touring, pausing at the Double Clutch Brewery & Restaurant in Evanston for lunch. While we could not view the brewery's entire collection of cars, much of which is housed in adjacent buildings, we did get to see a variety of European cars on display in the brewery itself. After lunch we concluded the tour at the All-Saints Shrine in Morton Grove, which is a church containing over 5000 religious relics. The priest and docents at this church provided very interesting and knowledgeable commentary about the relics on display there.

Our next event is the Illinois Region Fall Tour on October 16 through 19. Be sure to make your hotel reservation ASAP for this tour.
